To approve Planning Committee recommendations:
Recommend refusal:

 - Stow Longa Parish Council recommends refusal for the same reasons that Parish Council recommended refusal for the prior application.
 - The increase in size of the proposed dwellings from 3 /4 beds to 5 beds creates large houses which Parish Council believes to be incompatible with the site generally and the surrounding properties.
 - Stow Longa does not need any more 5 bed houses and requires more of a smaller size that are more affordable for young families.
