

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF STOW LONGA PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT ST.  
BOTOLPH'S PARISH CHURCH ON MONDAY 19 JULY 2010 AT 8 PM**

- 083/10 An apology for absence** was received from Cllr Hayes (holiday).
- 084/10 Declarations of Interest** - as to personal and prejudicial interest in relation to any agenda item - none
- 085/10 Public Open Forum** – none. No members of the public were present.
- 086/10 Minutes of Meeting held 14 June 2010** were approved and signed.
- 087/10 Matters arising from minutes**  
**Village Cross** – Cllr Millington reported that there had been no progress since Quinton Carroll's e-mail of 24 May 2010. It was, therefore, resolved that County Councillor Viv McGuire be asked to see what she can do to help the project along.  
**Dead tree on verge in Kimbolton Road** – Wayne Stewart, CCC tree officer, has advised that he will look at this when next in the area but, due to a significant backlog, this may take a while.

**To approve payments due** – none due.  
**Quarterly budget review** - The Clerk presented a statement of receipts and payments to 30 June 2010 which was in line with the budget. He also tabled the bank statement and copies of the cash book and bank reconciliation at 30 June which were examined and accepted as evidence that the accounts are being correctly maintained.

**Telephone Kiosk** – To note that BT is arranging for the telephony to be removed. When this has been done a completion notice and information pack will be sent to the PC.  
**Dog waste** – The consensus being that the large multi-purpose bins are inappropriate in a small village, it was agreed not to pursue this solution further. Instead it was decided to consider procuring two dog waste bins mounted on posts. The Clerk to obtain costs and to enquire how other parish councils emptied them. It was also agreed to carry out a further leaflet drop regarding the problem.
